Ian Allan OBE, FCIT



Ian Allan OBE, a School Governor from 1976 to 1983 and Treasurer and Chair of the Governors from 1983 until 1995, died on 23 June 2015, after a long fight with Parkinson's disease, just a day before his 93rd birthday.

A successful and pioneering publisher, Ian Allan is known to many as "the father of trainspotting". We remember him as a much respected Treasurer and lifelong generous and committed supporter of King Edward's Witley.
